To be considered for a Mid American Pompon Collegiate Scholarship, applicant must have:

1. Attended two or more Mid American Pompon functions (camp, competition, event, clinic, etc) as a competitor or participant by the application deadline. Applicants receive extra points for participation in additional MAPP events.
2. At least a 3.2+ cumulative Grade Point Average. (Transcripts through the applicant's junior year must be included with application).
3. Current status of "Senior/12th grade" at the High School level. No undergraduates or other pom team alumni will be considered.
